I.

In compliance with Section 58 Paragraph 2 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments of and Supplements to Other Acts (Higher Education Act), as amended, the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic announced on January 22, 2026 the base for setting the fees related to study for the academic year 2026/2027 at the amount of **CZK 5,278** (in words five thousand two hundred seventy-eight Czech crowns).

According to this base and in compliance with Appendix 2, Fees Related to Study at UCT Prague, to the internal regulation “Statute of the University of Chemistry and Technology, Prague”, the amounts of fees related to study are for the academic year 2026/2027 as follows:

In the academic year 2026/2027, a student studying in a bachelor’s or follow-up master’s study programme falling into the education area Chemistry, Food Science or Economics for more than the standard term of study increased by one year shall pay for the term of the first twelve months a fee equal to four times the base, i.e. the amount of CZK 21,112 rounded up to **CZK 21,200** (in words twenty one thousand two hundred Czech crowns) for each commenced six months of study; in the following years the student shall pay eight times the base, i.e. the amount of CZK 42,224 rounded up to **CZK 42,300** (in words forty-two thousand three hundred Czech crowns) for each commenced six months of study.

A student studying in a study programme provided in a foreign language shall pay a fee under Section 58 Paragraph 4 of the Higher Education Act. The amount of the fee for studying in a study programme provided in a foreign language and falling into the education area Chemistry, Food Science or Economics, shall be for the academic year 2026/2027:

Waiver, reduction, deferment or division in several payments of fees related to study.
Within the process of deciding on revision of the decision regarding charging a fee related to study, the Rector may waive, reduce, defer or divide the payment of the above stated fees, taking into account award of study results scholarship or social scholarship, extremely difficult study, social, health or family situation of the student and extraordinary professional or social representation of UCT Prague.

The Rector decides on the waiver, reduction or deferment of the fee based on the student's written appeal raised within 15 days of notification of the Dean's decision to charge the fee related to study; the appeal shall contain an attachment containing documents providing reasons for the appeal.

Further information, if necessary, shall be provided by the Department of Education.
