

Erasmus Mundus Clause - Option 1

In deviation of the applicable policy conditions and limits of insurance as mentioned on the insurance policy, the following extensions or limitations of coverage apply:

- In case of suicide or attempt of suicide, the costs of repatriation of insured to the home country are covered including the costs of a coffin. In such case the maximum limits of insurance are: for repatriation EUR 6.500 and for the coffin EUR 2.000
- With regards to the section Medical Expenses, pre-existing non-permanent mental disorders and non-chronic mental disorders will not be excluded.
- With regards to the section Medical Expenses, a pregnancy up to 6 months that existed at the moment of departure from the home country to travel directly to the destination country, shall not be excluded from coverage.
- Dental costs following an accident will be reimbursed in full.
- With regards to the section Liability, this insurance provides coverage in accordance with the applicable legal requirements and demonstrable mandatory coverage in the country of destination, provided that it is common for local insurers to offer that coverage.
- Coverage for travel is also applicable for students who follow an EMJMD+ program in their home country.
- There will be no coverage for Home Contents as stated in the applicable section of the policy conditions.
- With regards to the section Luggage, the limit of insurance is EUR 200. This limit does not apply for identification- and travel documents.
